ITINERARY

DAY 1 - Wednesday - 23 September, 2015: USA - ROME - Today we depart on our transatlantic flight to Rome.

DAY 2 - Thursday - 24 September, 2015: ROME - ASSISI - Arrive Rome's Fiumicino Airport in the morning. Upon arrival your tour escort will greet you. Transfer to Assisi. Settle in your hotel. Orientation tour of Assisi. Visit the Family Home and Birth Place of St. Francis. Mass at the Chiesa Nuova where Francis was imprisoned. Dinner in our hotel.

DAY 3 - Friday - 25 September, 2015: ASSISI - Visit and tour St. Francis Basilica. Celebrate Holy Mass at the Crypt Tomb of St. Francis. Tour the relics of St. Francis, his stigmata and tomb. Visit San Damiano Church. Pray in the chapel where Jesus spoke to St. Francis from the Cross. Visit St. Mary of The Angels Basilica where St. Francis spent most of his life. Here we will see: the Chapel, Portiuncula, the rose bush, and the cave where St. Francis retired for prayer. Dinner in our hotel.

DAY 4 - Saturday - 26 September, 2015: ASSISI - LORETO - LANCIANO - SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO - Enjoy breakfast in our hotel. We head towards Loreto to visit the Holy House of Nazareth and the beautiful Madonna of Loreto. It is said that this is the house where the Holy Family lived, and where Jesus grew up. It was transported by angels to this hill back in 1924. Continue to Lanciano to visit the Eucharistic Miracle and celebrate Holy Mass. Then, on to San Giovanni Rotondo for dinner and overnight.

DAY 5 - Sunday - 27 September, 2015: SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO - MICHAEL THE ARCHANGEL CAVE - Breakfast. Celebrate Holy Mass at the tomb of Padre Pio. Tour the sanctuary, the old church, Padre Pio's confessional, and the crucifix from which he received the stigmata in 1918. Visit the Grotto of Michael the Archangel, a shrine consecrated by St. Michael himself in 490. St. Francis and many popes have knelt in prayer at this grotto. Return to San Giovanni Rotondo for some free time, dinner and overnight.

DAY 6 - Monday - 28 September, 2015: SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO - MONTE CASSINO - ROME - Breakfast. Depart San Giovanni for Rome. On the way, stop at Monte Cassino, a gorgeous town founded by St. Benedict in 529. Arrive Rome late afternoon. Dinner in our hotel. Overnight.

DAY 7 - Tuesday - 29 September, 2015: ROME - Enjoy a tour of Rome's Basilicas which includes: the Basilica of St. Mary Major, the Holy Stairs, the Basilica of St. John the Lateran, St. Paul Outside the Walls, and the Appian Way -- the oldest road from Roman times -- (we will celebrate Holy Mass in one of the Basilicas) plus the famous Domino Quo Vadis Chapel, see the ancient Baths of Caracalla, Arch of Drusus, Tomb of Cecilia Metella, and the catacombs of St. Callistus where the early Christians hid themselves to escape persecution. Enjoy a visit of the Trevi Fountains before dinner in our hotel.

DAY 8 - Wednesday - 30 September, 2015: ROME (Pope's Audience) - This morning, we go to the Vatican to attend the weekly Papal Audience given by His Holiness Pope Francis (depending on the Pope's schedule and health). Afterwards, we visit the Vatican's Museums filled with art treasures and the unique Sistine Chapel (Michelangelo's Masterpiece). Then we will visit St. Peter's Basilica (the largest church in all of Christianity) built on the site where St. Peter was martyred. We will also visit the grave of Pope John Paul II located underneath St. Peter's Basilica. Celebrate Holy Mass at St. Peter's Basilica. Enjoy some time on your own before dinner and overnight.

DAY 9 - Thursday - 01 October, 2015: ROME - MEDJUGORJE - This morning, we will enjoy some free time for personal activities. In the afternoon, transfer to the airport to catch our 6:00pm flight to Split, Croatia. Upon arrival in Split, transfer to Medjugorje. Dinner and overnight.

DAYS 10 - 13 Thursday 02 October - Monday 05 October, 2015: MEDJUGORJE - Medjugorje is a simple mountain village. Experience its beauty, spirituality, and peace. During our stay, we will share our faith with thousands of people from all over the world. Each morning at 10:00am, we meet at St. James Church for the English language Mass (Feast days and Sundays English Mass is at noon). Our local bilingual tour guide will escort us to the Hill of Apparitions where the visionaries first saw Our Blessed Virgin Mary. Pray before the statue that symbolizes the place of the first apparition. In 1933 the villagers built a 30' high cross on the anniversary of Jesus' crucifixion on top of Cross Mountain (Križevac). We will climb the mountain through the Stations of the Cross. Also, visit and pray at "Blue Cross" - A place of healings and graces at the foot of Apparition Hill. We will have the chance to attend meetings and talks with the visionaries (subject to their availability and health during our trip). We will also visit the community of Canacolo (a rehab center). In the evening, we can join the villagers at 5:00pm (or 6:00pm daylight savings time) to pray the rosary. Followed by Croatian Mass during which there is the blessing of the items you have with you. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

RESERVATION AND PAYMENT: A reservation is confirmed upon receipt of a \$500.00 deposit per person and a signed registration form. Full payment is due 60 days prior to your departure date. Full payment is required for bookings made within 60 days of departure. A late fee of \$50.00 applies for reservations made within 3 weeks of the departure date. A written confirmation of the reservation will be mailed to you once the deposit has been processed.

NAME AS PER PASSPORT (IMPORTANT): for security reasons, airlines require that the passenger's name in the air reservations must exactly match the name as it appears on the passport. The Croatian Mir Center is not responsible for denied boarding or issue costs due to an incorrect name supplied to the Croatian Mir Center. We recommend that you send us a copy of your passport along with your registration form to ensure that all reservations and documents are properly ticketed.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: a valid US passport is required for travel. Passport must be valid 6 months after return date. Citizens of other countries should consult with the corresponding embassy or consulate for visa requirements. Cancellations due to lack of appropriate travel documents will incur usual penalties.

FINAL DOCUMENTS AND TICKETS: All documents will be sent by USPS second day delivery two weeks prior to your departure. Upon receipt of your travel documents, you are responsible to check your itinerary, name, times and other important information.

PRICE GUARANTEE: the price is guaranteed if paid in full. The pilgrim is responsible for any increase in published airfare or costs due to exchange rate fluctuations.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS: All cancellations must be made in writing. If you cancel your pilgrimage after you have received your documents and airline tickets,

you must return them back to the Croatian Mir Center before we can process your refund.
