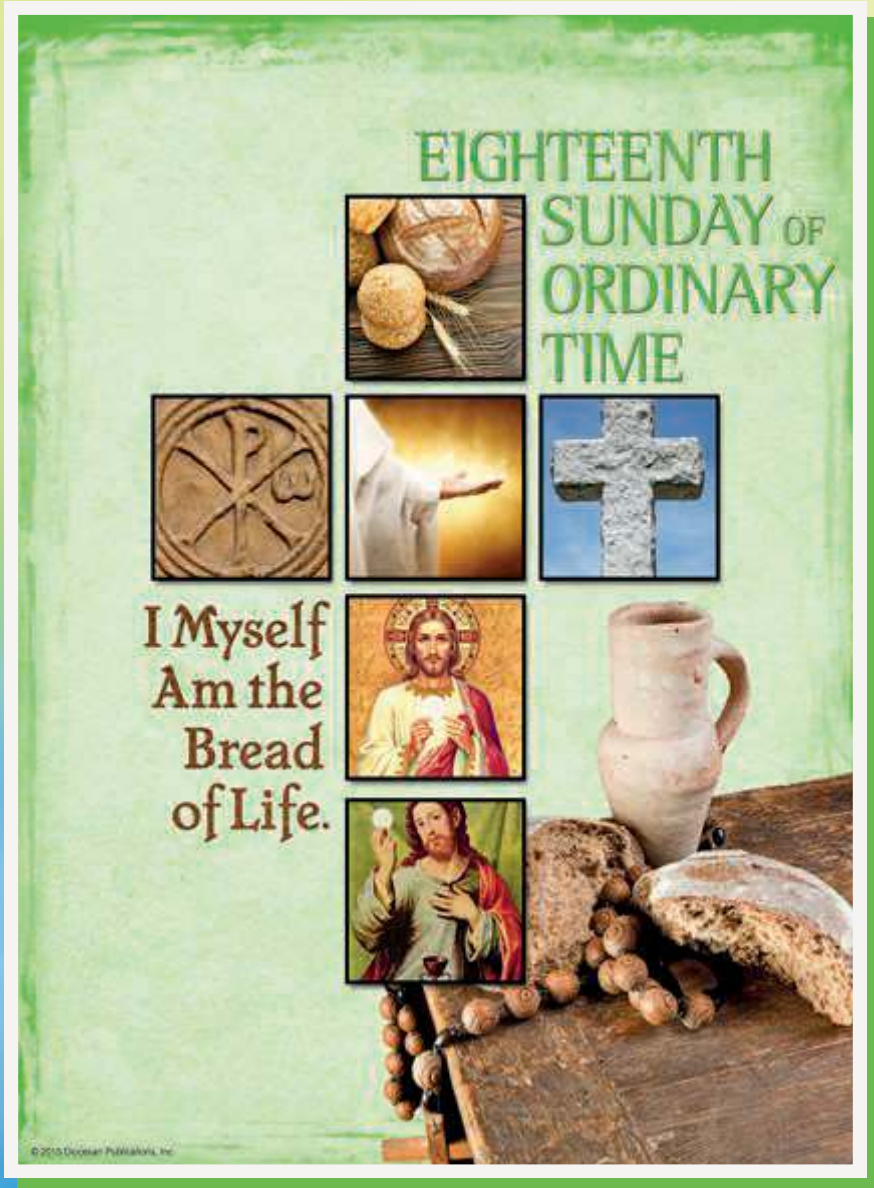

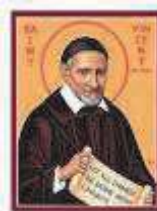

## A Letter from Our Bishop

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ:

Over the last few weeks we have listened to the missionary challenge given by Jesus Christ in the Gospels. The Scripture readings have challenged us to preach the Good News, to live the truth in love. The Apostles and disciples filled with missionary zeal preached the Word of God around the world and thus the Church has reached every corner of the globe.

Next weekend on August 8 & 9 the Diocese of Palm Beach will conduct a special collection for the Church in Latin America and the Solidarity Fund for the Church in Africa. Donations to these special collections will fund several ministries, particularly ministries that strengthen marriages and help families.

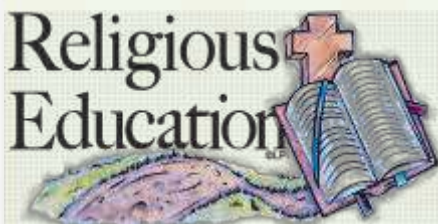

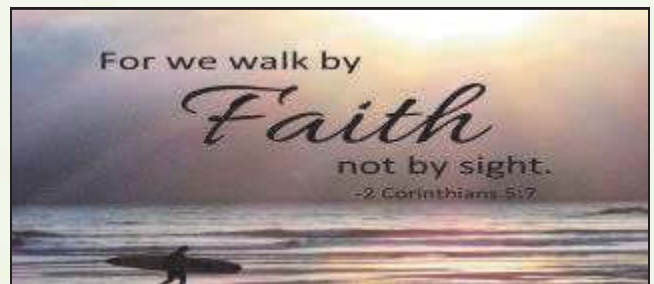

## Because of Faith

Since through faith we enter into the life of God, it is through faith that God begins his own within us. The purpose of our faith is for us to think as Jesus Christ does; to allow him, who is living in us through faith, to use us, think within us, and live in us. Because of faith, a complete change of our former way of seeing, thinking, feeling, and experiencing can take place. Faith changes our mentality, it tells us always to place God first, to be concerned with focusing our entire lives on him, and to interpret the world in the light coming from God. Then all of our judgments, evaluations, desires, and expectations are illuminated by the light of faith. In such a way communion of faith is brought about, a communion which will reach its fullness only in love. The created world surrounding us is a voice which speaks to us. If our faith is weak, the that voice distracts us, pulls us away from God, and focuses our attention on itself. As faith grows, the opposite process happens. The outside world begins to speak of God, focuses our attention on God, draws us to him, becomes a sign of his presence, helps us get in touch with him, and becomes a place where we encounter him. Faith enables us to overcome pretenses, to see the primary cause above the secondary causes. It allows us to see that what happens around us does not happen due to man's power.
