PreK/1	(ages 4,5 and 6 only - combined) Children are introduced to God as "The Good Shepherd," which allows them to grasp the truth of the gospel message and be grasped by it. By providing age-appropriate materials and removing any extraneous materials that might distract, the children work individually or with others in an atmosphere of reflection and self-expression. The 'classroom' in which this takes place is called an Atrium. <i>(Catechesis of the Good Shepherd)</i> *
2:	First Reconciliation and First Communion. (Faith and Life: Ignatius Press + Baltimore Catechism One: Tan Publishing)
	Although all other classes will be held on Sunday mornings <u>a special</u> <u>Grade 2 class option will be offered on Tuesday afternoons</u> utilizing <i>Catechesis of the Good Shepherd</i> materials in preparing children for 1 <sup>st</sup> Communion and Reconciliation. Some Sunday attendance will be recommended as well.*
3:	Life with Jesus. Emphasis on Parables. (Faith and Life: Ignatius Press + Catechesis of the Good Shepherd)
4:	Old Testament. Salvation History. (Faith and Life: Ignatius Press + Catholic Children's Bible: St. Mary's Press)
5:	The Creed. (Faith and Life: Ignatius Press)
