Grades K-7 Faith Formation Curriculum

K/1: (ages 5 and 6 only - combined)

Children are introduced to God as "The Good Shepherd," which allows them to grasp the truth of the gospel message and be inspired by it. By providing age-appropriate materials and removing any extraneous materials that might distract, the children work individually or with others in an atmosphere of reflection and self-expression. The 'classroom' in

which this takes place is called an Atrium.

Due to the limited class sizes required in Atrium learning, Sunday morning, Tuesday morning and Tuesday afternoon sessions are scheduled. (Catechesis of the Good Shepherd)*
